SCHOOL NEWS:

Information for Seniors:

*All money and tickets for the Sober Grad \$1 raffle are due to Mrs. Aguiar by TODAY. The drawing is being held on Monday, 5/22/17, at the last Sober Grad meeting.

*Seniors, the Awards Assembly is on Thursday, 5/25/17, at 6:00 pm in the gym. All seniors are invited to attend. If you will be receiving an award, you received a special invitation by mail.

*Seniors, the Graduation Ceremony Rules and Guidelines that were handed out during Advisory on Friday must be signed by you and your parents/guardians and turned into Mrs. Aguiar in the Career Center by Tuesday, 5/23/17. Extra copies are available in the office.

*Seniors, the preferred seating tickets for graduation are now available in the Career Center. Each senior is eligible to receive 3 tickets, but you must pick them up by Wednesday, 5/24/17, or they will no longer be available to you. If you are interested in having more than 3 tickets, you can put your name on the waiting list (first come, first served). You will be notified after 5/24/17 if extra tickets are available.

*Seniors that turned in a cap contract, all caps must be completely decorated and turned in to the school by Monday, 5/22/17. At 3:15 on 5/22/17, there will be a senior gathering in the Career Center to turn in decorated caps and for all seniors that ordered a yearbook to receive their copy. If you can't attend the event after school, your cap must be turned in to the office during the school day on 5/22/17 by 3:30 (or sooner).

*Seniors, if you do not have a cap and gown, please let either Mrs. Hogg in the office or Mrs. Aguiar in the Career Center know ASAP so we can help you. Reminder that caps were removed from your package if you didn't turn in a cap contract, and they will be handed out the evening of graduation in the MPR.

*Seniors that need to appeal being able to participate in the graduation ceremony due to the attendance policy need to make sure their appeal letter is turned into Mr. Rowe by no later than Monday, 5/22/17, at 3:15.

Seniors will receive their yearbooks after school on Monday, May 22, in the Career Center. All other grades will receive their yearbooks after school on Friday, May 26th in the Career Center. Yearbooks will not be distributed during class time.

Time & yearbooks are running out! Buy yours before it's too late. All purchases must be made in room 5. Deposits are accepted to hold your book.

All students that plan to participate in athletics for the 2017-18 school year, OHS is having a **free** physical night on Tuesday, 5/30/17, from 5:00-7:00 in the gym. Physicals are required to participate in any sport, and they are good for the entire school year. Each Student will need to have a Physical Examination Form which is available in the office or on the school website.

Summer School is June 5-16th and all who have turned in their applications are guaranteed placement. Students who are not on graduation track and fail to make up credits may become ineligible for extracurricular activities. Please turn your forms in **ASAP** as space is limited.

Freshman, Sophomores and Juniors that have **Work Permits**, unless your Work Permit was issued on 4/26/17 or later, it expires on the last day of school. If you will be working during the summer, you need to do a new request for a Work Permit that will be good through the summer. Seniors are not required to have Work Permits once they graduate, even if they are under 18 years old.
