

## 📍 OHS Senior Community Connection

All OHS seniors are required to complete a minimum of 16 hours of community service for a local organization. This project is a way to teach the students to give back to the community that is often so generous to them. The organization your child chooses to volunteer for must be approved in advance by the Orland High School Administrators.

Each senior will prepare and give an oral presentation, including a PowerPoint with pictures of their community service, on one of the organizations. Presentations are after school and will be presented to a panel of judges. More information will be given to the students later in the year regarding their presentation.

### **Student Requirements**

- Each senior student will complete 16 hours of community service for an organization that has been approved by OHS. The “work” can be completed for one or more of the organizations.
- The student is expected to abide by all normal school rules during the volunteer work.
- The student will be supervised by an adult from the organization while volunteering and will not be under the direct supervision of an employee of OUSD.
- The student is responsible for transportation to and from the organization’s “work site”.
- All of the volunteer work is completed on the student’s “own time”, not during school hours.
- The student is responsible for showing up to a “job” that he/she signed up for. Please treat community service as a priority and do not leave the organization short-handed.
- The student will arrive on time and render quality service to the organization.
- Orland Unified School District accepts no liability during the course of the volunteer work, as well as during the transportation to and from the activity.
- In the event of an accident, illness, or any other circumstance requiring medical treatment, such treatment may be procured without financial obligation to the Orland Unified School District.
- The student will be responsible for completing time card(s) for volunteer work and having them signed by the organization’s supervisor. Time card(s) must be turned into the Career Center. (Part of Portfolio)
- The student will prepare and give an oral presentation, including a PowerPoint with pictures of their community service, on one of the organizations they volunteered for by May 05 2017. All presentations take place after school.
