

## **Local wrestlers shine at Corning Invite**

Considering the fact that wrestlers from 41 teams competed in the Corning Invitational Tournament over the weekend, the showing by tri-county area teams as well as by individual wrestlers is that much more impressive.

Orland High School finished third overall with 137.5 points, finishing only behind champion Pleasant Valley (179) and Modoc (138). Corning and Willows were also in the top 10, with Corning coming in sixth with 113.5, and Willows eighth, with 103.5.

Glenn County produced a pair of 2nd-place finishers, with Orland's Nathan Monck making his way to the finals before being defeated by Corning's Kodie Brown in the finals at 114; and Willows' Daniel Garcia taking second after losing to Henley's Aaron David at 132 - each wrestler falling to the top seed in their weight classes.

Also finishing in the top-three for their classes from Orland were: Christien Wathen (132) Bret Schuman (147) and Craig Simons (154), all with third-place finishes.
