**Butte College Reg-To-Go 2016-17 Schedule**

Seniors, who wish to participate in Reg-To-Go, **must meet all deadlines and attend all of the scheduled activities**, in order to have and maintain priority registration through the Reg2Go.

- Apply      Apply at [www.butte.edu](http://www.butte.edu) , opens November 2. Students apply as a High School Graduate, attending college for the 1<sup>st</sup> time, with a graduation date of 6/2/16. Be sure to check YES to the Reg-To-Go question, and print the application Confirmation page.
- \*Have you already applied to Butte while in high school? You need to reapply and then call 895-2511 to change status from concurrent to graduate.
- Once you receive your Butte College ID #, you will need to sign up for the Basic Skills Assessment in the Counseling Office using your ID # and birthdate.
- Apply      FSA ID – You and your parent must have a FSA ID to submit a FAFSA application. Apply at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) , click on the FSA ID link.
- Dec. 8      Classroom Visitation – Econ, Civics, Ag. Business, N.V. & I/S – Your teacher has schedule.
- Jan. 1      FAFSA **2016-17** - First day to submit an application – [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) .
- Jan. 23      “Cash for College” Free application for Federal Student Aid Workshop, 10:00 am in the Career Center. Experts will be available to help families complete the FAFSA; Bring your 2015 tax information or 2014 Federal Tax records to estimate 2015 income. Spanish Translation services provided.
- March 2      FAFSA deadline for Cal Grant Program eligibility.
- Feb. 29      **Deadline to RSVP a seat for the** Basic Skills Assessment. Sign up with your Butte College ID # and birthdate in the Counseling Office.
- March 8      **Basic Skills Assessment, Career Center. Bring photo ID and Butte College ID #.**
- March 24      Parent permission and Activity release forms for Orientation and Registration at Butte College are due to counseling office.
- April 12      **Orientation and Registration – at Butte College main campus. Bus departs from OHS at 7:30, returns by 3:00 p.m. Bring money for lunch.**
- April 18      Butte College Fees must be paid or a Payment Plan set up or your classes will be dropped. If you don't attend Butte in the fall semester, you can request a refund.
