Through WUE, students may enroll in participating two-year and four-year public college programs at a reduced tuition level: up to 150 percent of the institution's regular resident tuition. In all cases, WUE tuition is considerably less than nonresident tuition.

Which States Participate?

Resident students from the following states may participate, if they meet eligibility requirements:

Alaska Arizona California Colorado Hawaii Idaho Montana Nevada New Mexico
North Dakota Oregon South Dakota Utah Washington Wyoming
Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands

Programs Available

Virtually all undergraduate fields are available to WUE students at one or more of the participating colleges and universities. Some institutions have opened their entire curriculum on a space-available or first-come, first-served basis. Others offer only designated programs at the discounted WUE rate.

Eligibility

Many institutions require evidence of academic performance, such as ACT/SAT test scores or high school GPA, or place other conditions on WUE enrollment.

Application and Admission

Apply directly to the institution(s) of your choice for admission and WUE tuition status. Mark prominently on the institution's application form that you seek admission as a WUE student.
